


## **OUT OF CONTROL**

## FINANCES September 6-7, 2014

- · Open in prayer.
- What do these statements say to you?
  - o What does it mean to "steward" our money?
  - o Money is a litmus test of where our true treasure is.
  - o Jesus said, "Where your treasure is, there your heart is also."
- When the world is out of control, how do you steward God's money?
- Tap into the riches of Christ Jesus' grace.
  - o Read 2 Corinthians 8:9
  - o Every human being was/is spiritually dead—spiritually separated from God.
  - o It's not about money, it's about God's grace.
- Read Ephesians 2:1-7
  - o Jesus didn't come to make bad people good; he came to make spiritually dead people alive in Him.
  - o Humility should be the fragrance that we wear when we realize that at the foot of the cross every single human being is in need of grace.
  - o What is God's "big but" in this passage?
  - o Discipleship is growing in your appreciation of God's love, grace and mercy.
- When was the last time you drank from the well of unending mercy and grace?
- When was the last time you were appreciative of God's mercy and grace?
  - o Read Psalm 103:11
  - o How great is God's love?
- Give generously to the cause of Christ through your local church first, and then give to other Christcentered ministries.
  - o The first check you and I should write is the check to the local church.
  - o If we wait to give to God with our "leftovers", there won't be anything "left over".
  - o Giving is a by-product of Grace.
- Read 2 Corinthians 8:1-6
  - o Discuss where Paul said, "In the midst of a very severe trial, their overflowing joy and their extreme poverty welled up in rich generosity."
  - o How does this passage reflect living an upward, inward, outward life through our generosity?
- Develop a budget, for the glory of Christ.
  - o There are two ways to look at our budget. Discuss the chart on the next page, and what it means for us to give according to God's Generosity.
  - o Encourage your TC group members to attend the Transform U:Finance workshop.





- Read and discuss each verse of 2 Corinthians 9:12-15.
  - o It's really not about money; it's about receiving the grace of God and allowing God's grace to move through our generosity.
- Learn to be content in Christ
  - o Read Philippians 4:11-13
- The American economy spends all of its time encouraging us not to be content.
- How does your life change when you live contentedly in Christ?
- Read 1 Timothy 6:17-19
  - o How does this passage speak to us today—especially in our giving?
  - o How does giving change your life? Does your giving change your life?
- Read Philippians 4:15-20
  - o Giving is an act of worship—it's a sweet-smelling offering to God.
  - o We receive a reward—God will meet your needs. He is true to his promises.
  - o How is giving an act of worship in response to His grace?
- **Soul-Tattoo:** Tap into Jesus' grace: Give generously, develop a budget, and learn contentment.
