- 5. Discuss the following chart and answer the questions below.

Orphan	Child of God
Orphans feel condemned, guilty, and unworthy of God's love and others.	Children of God feel loved, forgiven, and totally accepted by God the Father because of Jesus' eptastic finished work!
Orphans have little faith. They will 'fix it.'	Children of God trust in God the Papa's sovereign loving care. God's got this!
Orphans need to be right, safe, and secure. Unwilling to fail. Can't handle criticism, and can only 'handle' praise.	Children of God are able to take risks and even fail because Jesus is their righteousness! They don't need a record to boast in, protect, or defend.
