- 1. Open in prayer.
- 2. Read Matthew 6:7-13
  - What new thing(s) have you discovered about the Lord's Prayer so far during this series?
- 3. Read Romans 14:17
  - The Kingdom of God is where Jesus rules as King. How does this verse translate into how we live our everyday lives? (Law vs. Grace)
- 4. The Kingdom of God is a community of people marked by righteousness and peace.
  - In the following verses, read how living "in Him" marks us with righteousness and peace. What "one thing" can we take away from each verse?

Psalm 85:10 Philippians 3:8-9
Romans 5:1 Colossians 1:19-22
Ephesians 1:13-14 Romans 1:18-21

- 5. Read Matthew 5:44-48
  - The Kingdom of God is a community of people marked by love. It's easy to love those who are like us, but how do we treat people who look different from us?
  - Do we see everyone as a person created in the image of God? How does that change the way we treat people?

## 6. Read Romans 15:13

- The Kingdom of God is a community of people marked by joy.
- Why do we look to external things to give us joy? What external things do we or have we looked to for joy? Give examples.
- What does the statement, "Jesus should be primary in our lives and everything else should be secondary," mean for us?
- God the Papa wants to bring heavenly conditions to earth through us. What does that look like for us at home? At work? At school?
