· Open in prayer.

Introduction

- o The life you were created for is caring for the things that God cares about.
- o As God captures our heart, the more the things that capture His heart will capture our heart.
- o God will take an ordinary person in an extraordinary situation and will do supernatural things.
- o How can these statements transform the way you currently live?

• Read Nehemiah 2:10-16

- o Nehemiah's life was good but he was concerned with the lives of others.
- o The greater we love God the greater we'll love all people.
- o He risked everything for the welfare of the people.

HOW DO WE DEVELOP HEARTS THAT SEEK THE WELFARE OF PEOPLE?

Let God's vision become your vision.

- o Read Nehemiah 2:10
- Nehemiah's life was good, but he was concerned with the lives of others and he was driven by God's vision towards the needs of others.
- o Discuss the following statement: God's vision is like a tractor beam that pulls us out of self-centeredness to God-centeredness, that sends us on mission towards other people-centeredness.
- o Read Luke 10:25-29
- o A deeper love for God causes us to love our neighbors.
- o What is God's vision? (Hint: Upward, Inward, Outward)
- o Who is your neighbor? (be specific)
- o What does loving your neighbor mean in a practical sense?

• Let God's vision move you past criticism.

- o Read Nehemiah 2:10
- o When you decide to follow and trust Jesus, you will get criticized, made fun of, and ostracized.
- o Is God's vision and call for your life more important than your friends?
- o Who has your best interest in mind? Jesus or your friends?
- o How does following God's vision currently affect your life?

• Let what breaks God's heart break your heart: Lost people and injustice!

- o Read Matthew 4:19-20
- o If your discipleship doesn't increase your capacity to see lost people come to Jesus your discipleship isn't worth much.
- o How does this statement change the view some people have regarding discipleship? (information vs. transformation)
- o Before you talk to people about Jesus, talk to Jesus about people.
- o How does that statement change the way we share God's love with others?
- o As a group, pray the following:

1. **To love God completely** Celebrate all that He has done for us and worship Him for His

overwhelming love and grace.

2. **To love ourselves correctly** Recognize our identity is in Christ and Him alone.

3. **To love others compassionately** Discover ways to be the heart, hands and feet of Christ in every area of

our lives.



• Read Matthew 25:35-46

- o If our community doesn't get better because we're here, we shouldn't be here.
- o Discuss our value of being a Servant Community: We are committed, by the Spirit's enabling power, to develop a biblical, servant-hearted community, in which we serve each other through our grace-gifts as we serve in our spheres of influence by being the heart, hands, and feet of Jesus.
- o How are we changing our community?
 - Indian Land Schools
 - Kershaw Prison
 - Children's Attention Home
 - Lancaster Pregnancy Center
