Open in prayer.

Introduction.

- Have you ever seen something so beautiful that it captivated you?
- Have you ever placed your trust, peace, or hope in someone or something other than Jesus? What happened?
- Discuss the statement, No one has loved or had compassion or provided a vision for life that is more beautiful than Jesus.
- If you grew up in the church, how was "eternal life" described?
- How does the following definition of "eternal life" transform the way we live? Eternal life means that Jesus, through the power of the Holy Spirit, shares His beautiful eternal life with us so that God can have a beautiful family here on earth that mirrors heaven. (HINT: When we declare who God is, we know who we are, and we can display God's glory to a hurt world.)

Read and discuss Romans 15:5-13.

- This Scripture begins with a prayer and ends with a prayer.
- How many times do you read "give God glory" or "give glory"?

What's the problem?

Ethnic disunity diminishes the glory of God.

- There's only one race...the human race.
- The human race is made up of many ethnicities.
- Paul only started ethnically diverse churches that reflected the new heaven and new earth.
- What's wrong with Ethnocentrism (my ethnic group is better than yours)?
- Why do you think so many churches in America are mono-ethnic (homogeneous)?
- Why does ethnic disunity diminish God's glory?

What's God's desire?

Live in harmony with one another, praising and glorifying God with one voice.

Read and discuss Romans 15:5-6.

- How does praying, "Thy will be done" instead of "my will be done" change the way we pray?
- Why do we need patience and encouragement to live in complete harmony with one another?
- How do the following statistics speak against this Scripture?
- Nine out of ten churches are homogeneous...mono-ethnic.
- Local churches are ten times more segregated than the schools they are around.
- Local churches are twenty times more segregated than the neighborhoods they are around.
- Discuss this statement: If you want to know if you love yourself correctly, watch how you treat people.

What's God's desire?

Accept each other the way Christ accepted you.

Read and discuss Romans 15:7.

- When we accept others as Christ accepted us, we bring God glory.
- Is there someone—an individual or group—you have a difficult time accepting?
- How does remembering how Christ accepted you change the way you think about that person or group?

What gives us the power to fulfill God's desire?

The Gospel

- The word "gospel" (evangelism) was taken from the Romans.
- When a new emperor appeared, he would send out apostles (messengers) who would proclaim the gospel (good news) of a new emperor.
- They would tell the Romans if you bow your knee to him and confess him as savior and lord he will bring you peace and prosperity.
- Why is it important for Christians to use words from our culture?



What gives us the power to fulfill God's desire? The Person and work of the Messiah through the Holy Spirit. Read and discuss Romans 15:8.

- Messiah means anointed one.

Read and discuss Romans 15:9-12.

- Paul is reminding the Jews that it's not about ethnicities, it's about the blood of Christ and His transformation to creating a beautiful people in Christ.
- Why is it important for us to never forget what it was like before we knew Jesus?
- How do we know someone has experienced God's mercy in their hearts?

Read and discuss Galatians 3:8-9.

Result: We glorify God by becoming a preview of heaven on earth. (Hope, Joy, Peace.) Read and discuss Romans 15:13.

- Discuss the following statements:
 - Our hope is in God because He is immutable (unchangeable).
 - Our joy is rooted in our relationship with the One who is Joy Himself.
 - Our peace is found in the Prince of Peace.
- How does the following statement change the way we look at eternal life? God's greatest goal isn't to get you to heaven when you die, but to get in you so that you're a preview of Him to a world that needs Him!

Soul-tattoo: Say "Yes" to praising and glorifying God.

- Transformers, go deeper into what it means to be an owner of Transformation Church.
- Teens, get connected at TC Teens if you're not connected to your parents' TC group. Grow in the Five Characteristics of a Transformer.
