- Open in prayer.
- Introduction
- First Value at TC
- A High and Lofty View of God

We are committed, through the Spirit's enabling power, to teach a high and lofty view of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. All our actions, teaching, prayer, mission, and spiritual transformation will be driven by our view of God.

- o Discuss the above value and why it's important for it to be our first value.
- o What did Pastor Paul mean when he said, "Who or what we worship affects who we are, what we believe, and what we do?"

• The Creator expresses Himself through the created.

• Read Romans 1:18-20.

- o Why does God send His wrath on the ungodly and unrighteous who suppress the truth?
- o What truth are they suppressing?
- o Discuss what "common grace" is according to verses 19 and 20.
- o Give examples of how creation expresses God's eternal power and divine nature.

• People chose to worship the created.

- Read and discuss Romans 1:21-23.
 - o Why do we say at TC "all of life is worship"?
 - o What happens when someone worships the created instead of the Creator?
- Read 1 John 2:16.
- Give examples (both small and large) of how these three sins can be evident in our lives.
- o Desires of the flesh.
- o Desires of the eyes.
- o Pride of life.

• The Creator allows people to follow their own ways.

- Read and discuss Romans 1:24-32.
 - o How many times did Paul say, "God gave them up"?
 - o What "dishonorable passions" (lusts of their hearts) were people doing?
 - o What are the characteristics of a "debased mind"? Choose and discuss a few of the ones listed.
 - o Discuss the following statements:
 - Our hope is not to make people better, our hope is for people to receive God's forgiveness for their sins through Jesus.
 - Transformation comes from the inside out...it's a heart change. Sometimes His love means letting go of people and letting them experience the results of their choices.
 - o How are we seeing verse 32 lived out in today's culture?
 - o How can today's cultural changes affect the church (gathering of Christ followers)?



• The Creator is kind, but not soft.

• Read and discuss Romans 2:1-5.

o Discuss how living an upward, inward, outward life changes us from being the person in this passage.

• Soul Tattoo: Marinate on the Creator's overwhelming love this week.

o Practice walking in God's upward, inward, outward love this week. Before every decision, conversation, action...take a moment and walk through His love...are we loving God completely, ourselves correctly, and others compassionately with the thing we're about to do or the words we're about to say.
